## GENERAL RULES

---

Under the scope of the 20th anniversary of the fall of the Berlin Wall, the Portuguese Printing Press Museum and Jornal de Notícias are promoting an international contest to reward the best photography of the wall.

### DESCRIPTION

It is intended to evoke the fall of the Berlin Wall symbol of the intransigence and the "cold war" and to call for reflection on Freedom, Citizenship, Tolerance and the Right to Difference.

### RECIPIENTS

The competition is open to any citizen, regardless of place of residence.

### TIME

Until **December 31, 2009**.

### APPLICATION CONDITIONS

**1.** To join the contest just send the photos properly identified and together with a digital form that is presented on the sites of the **Portuguese Printing Press Museum** ([www.museudaimprensa.pt](http://www.museudaimprensa.pt)) and **Jornal de Notícias Online** (<http://jn.sapo.pt>)

**2.** Each participant can compete with one or more images.

**3.** Only be accepted photographs whose registration form is properly completed (name, date of birth, address and telephone number of the author) and dated.

### DIVULGATION

**1.** The photographs will be shown, as well as the authors, in a Virtual Gallery created for that purpose on the website of the PORTUGUESE PRINTING PRESS MUSEUM.

**2.** The winning photographs can be published by the PORTUGUESE PRINTING PRESS MUSEUM and JORNAL DE NOTÍCIAS in a non-profit edition, not fitting the authors to claim any rights.

**3.** If the works are edited for profit purposes, the division of duties will be shared equally between the author (s) (s), the PORTUGUESE PRINTING PRESS MUSEUM and JORNAL DE NOTÍCIAS.

### JURY

The jury will have an odd number of members and will be composed by well known photographers and photography critics. Their decision will be final with no subjection to any kind of appeal or reclamation.

### PRIZES

Prizes will consist of publications of the PORTUGUESE PRINTING PRESS MUSEUM and JORNAL DE NOTÍCIAS.
